Grandad Wing Walk

On the 16th August 2017, one of our founding members took to the sky in a bid to raise money for ACF-UK. At the tender age of 68, Joseph Jeyakumar, pictured below, embarked on one of the most courageous, heroic stunts of his life. Jeyam soared 500ft in the air at a speed of 135mph on a 1940s Boeing Stearman Biplane while standing on the wing of a plane. The Grandad of three was cheered on by his family and the ACF-UK Chairman.

“My family said it was not safe, but I managed to convince them, and they have been very supportive. I had never done anything like this before. Hundreds of children have already been sponsored this year by people fundraising through marathons and I knew I had to do something to play my part.
